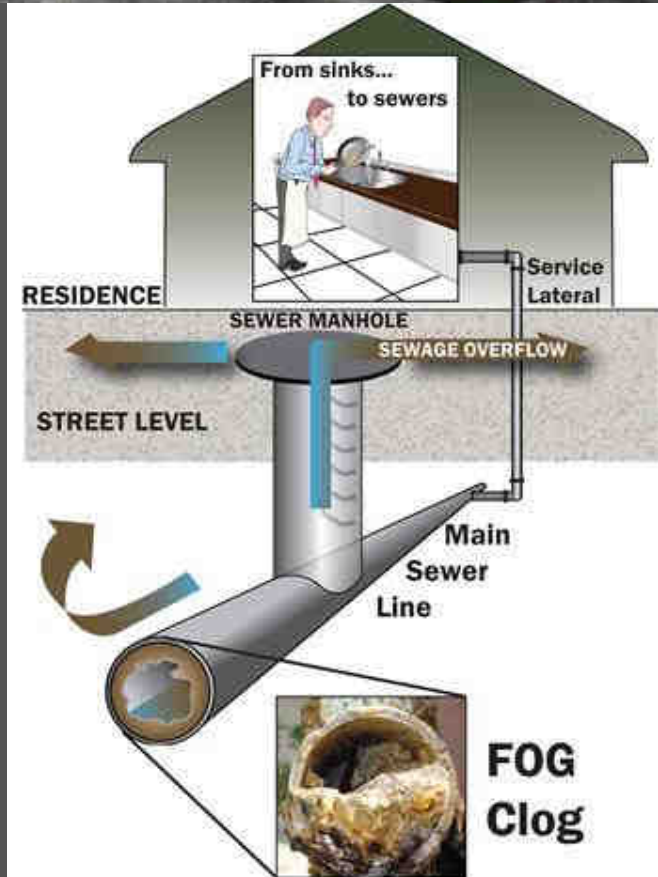


Fats oils and grease (FOG) come from meats, butters, lard, food scraps, sauces, dressings, dairy products and cooking oil.

When Fog goes down the drain, it hardens and causes sewer pipes to clog. This can lead to a sanitary sewer overflow where raw sewage actually backs up into your home, lawn and streets. It can lead to a nearby stream or river, which affects our drinking water.

Scrape food scraps, oil, grease and sauces from plates and utensils into the trash and dispose of them properly.

Don't pour oil or grease down the drain or garbage disposal.

Current service in River Oaks: **ACCESS paratransit & bus route 91.**

Options:

- **If the City decides to continue with Trinity Metro, River Oaks customers will maintain the current level of service.**
- **If the City chooses to discontinue, River Oaks customers would no longer have ACCESS or bus operations.**

If you would like to voice your opinion about keeping ACCESS in River Oaks, consider attending the public meeting on Nov. 22. Your trip to and from the meeting will be provided at no charge to you.
