The City of River Oaks has begun construction of several improvements to the City's Water System. These improvements consist of improvements to the Surface Water Treatment Plant. Clarifier Reconstruction as the first phase of construction, to be followed by extensive upgrading and replacement of the City's Water Distribution System Infrastructure. This first phase of construction addresses the complete replacement of all internal parts and components of the City's Clarifier, which is an integral part of the Surface Water Treatment Plant. These improvements will bolster the City's ability to provide improved water quality to the citizens of River Oaks. The Water Distribution System Improvements will replace the vast majority of old water mains previously installed between 1940 to the mid 1960's. These improvements will greatly improve water flow, clarity of water by the elimination of old rusty water lines and provide increase fire flow capability for added fire protection. These improvements are wholly funded through the EPA under the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program administered by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB).
